While most people prefer to call the 2-1-1/Crisis Hotline with questions, others use the Online Resource Directory. The Online Resource Directory is located at http://www.referweb.net/chic/.

There, you can search by Category, Service or Agency Name. You can refine your search by providing a zip code or city and your age and gender. No personal information is ever collected about your search.

The Online Resource Directory can also be searched in different languages and you can post searches on social media or email resources to friends and family. Agencies can log in here to update their listings.

Starting in this issue, Pathways will begin providing statistics on the searches of our directory. Keep in mind that some data like "Top Searches by City" are based on visitors entering a community or zip code.


