SNAP & Local Farmer's Markets - How does it work?

An entire farmer's market becomes a licensed SNAP retailer – so any vendor who sells SNAP-eligible products at that farmer's market can accept SNAP as payment. The Canal Market District will be the only farmer's market in Licking County to accept SNAP, starting June 3.

Any farmer who sells SNAP eligible products can accept SNAP tokens as payment. The Canal Market District will also be certified to accept the WIC Farmer's Market Nutrition Coupons, so any farmer at the market who sells eligible food items can accept these coupons as payment.

Ohio also offers:

- WIC Farmer's Market Nutrition Program coupons. These are different from the regular monthly WIC benefits. These coupons can only be used at farmer's markets on specific food items. A limited quantity is distributed in each county each year through the WIC program, locally at the Knox County and Licking County Health Departments. An entire farmer's market can become licensed to accept the WIC Farmer's Market Nutrition Program Coupons or an individual farmer or farm market can become licensed.

- Senior Farmer's Market Nutrition Program coupons (similar to WIC, these can only be used at farmer's markets). A limited quantity is distributed in each county each year (distributed by LifeCare Alliance, through the Licking County Aging Program). Only individual farmers can apply to accept these Senior Farmer's Market Nutrition Program coupons.
