2-1-1 December Community Report



Whole Living Recovery is a Newark, Ohio based, not-for-profit recovery housing program for adult women and men who are 18 years and older dealing with addiction. This includes women who are pregnant or caring for a young child. Whole Living Recovery provides a safe environment but expects residents to display accountability and a desire to live in recovery.

Residences where clients reside while participating in Whole Living Recovery are referred to as *Awakening Lane* for women and *Norpell Lane* for men. Both are private homes in a residential neighborhood. The residences have double occupancy and single rooms and shared bathrooms.

Common spaces include a living room with a TV, a dining room and a kitchen. The facility is fully furnished and provides all the necessary utensils and linens. Clients are responsible for acquiring food and preparing meals.

Incoming clients have to be clean for at least 30 days prior to move in. They must also have a personal recovery plan. They can also expect to have an initial in-depth assessment and referral by a counselor.

Whole Living Recovery homes, Norpell Lane and Awakening Lane are safe havens for those looking for a support system while figuring out how to live in recovery. Clients practice accountability while living in the home and take on new healthy habits that are conducive to stability in recovery.




Both Knox and Licking Counties receive calls for the same types of services and agencies. These graphs/charts will give you an idea of needs and referrals based on call data for your individual communities.

Below are some tips to help you with your Online Resource Directory search.

SEARCH Guide

* Add the location where you are looking for services. You can add the city and/or zip. By adding a zip code your results will sort by proximity to that zip code.

* Look for an **Agency** OR a **Specific type of Service**.

- If you are looking for a specific Agency be sure to use the proper name. If you do not know the full name use the keyword field to search.

- Use the **Service Category** field to search for a service. Begin typing and we will suggest categories that are in our database.

* To narrow your results even further, use the **Area Served** field to only return results that are available in the area you are looking for help. You can enter a city or specific zip code.
