

- * Pathways 2-1-1/Crisis Hotline received 26,901 calls last year from people who needed help.
- * Pathways 2--11/Crisis Hotline provides a vital link between service providers and those who most need assistance.
- * Anyone who needs help in Knox, Licking, Morgan, Muskingum, Perry, Pickaway and Washington counties can reach Pathways 2-1-1/Crisis Hotline simply by dialing 2-1-1 on their telephone, or by texting their zip code to 898-211. Marion County residents can reach us by calling 800-544-1601.
- * Anyone who calls the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline number (1-800-273-TALK) in the counties we serve will reach Pathways 2-1-1/Crisis Hotline's highly trained counselors.
- * Pathways 2-1-1/Crisis Hotline's services are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year.
- * Pathways 2-1-1/Crisis Hotline maintains an extensive service directory of 1,067 agencies and detailed listings of more than 3,000 services and programs to which callers can be referred. This information is available to the public either by calling 2-1-1 or on the Pathways 2-1-1/Crisis Hotline website at 211pathways.com.
- * Over half of the callers contacting Pathways 2-1-1/Crisis Hotline were looking for access

to basic needs including food assistance, medical care, housing, utility assistance or rent assistance.




Knox and Licking County Call Totals for the Past 12 Months



Below are some tips to help you with your Online Resource Directory search.

SEARCH Guide

- * Add the location where you are looking for services. You can add the city and/or zip. By adding a zip code your results will sort by proximity to that zip code.
- * Look for an Agency OR a Specific type of Service.
- If you are looking for a specific Agency be sure to use the proper name. If you do not know the full name use the keyword field to search.
- Use the **Service Category** field to search for a service. Begin typing and we will suggest categories that are in our database.
- * To narrow your results even further, use the **Area Served** field to only return results that are available in the area you are looking for help. You can enter a city or specific zip code.
- * Click Search
