Donors can visit the website <u>uwayknox.org/Respond</u> to place on online donation using their credit card information. If individuals or organization are interested in contributing to the fund,








The Top Agency graph below no longer includes Answering Service calls as a "referral".

SEARCH Guide

- * Add the location where you are looking for services. You can add the city and/or zip. By adding a zip code your results will sort by proximity to that zip code.
- * Look for an **Agency** OR a **Specific type of Service**.
- If you are looking for a specific Agency be sure to use the proper name. If you do not know the full name use the keyword field to search.
- Use the **Service Category** field to search for a service. Begin typing and we will suggest categories that are in our database.
- * To narrow your results even further, use the **Area Served** field to only return results that are available in the area you are looking for help. You can enter a city or specific zip code.
- * Click Search
