Dear Readers,

Normally in this space, we share information about services in Licking and Knox Counties that you need to know about to better serve your clients and customers. This month, I would like to give you an update on Pathways of Central Ohio.

First and foremost, Pathways is still here for you. Pathways is serving the community as we always have but in new and creative ways. Nearly all staff are now working from home

and this includes our 2-1-1/Crisis Hotline staff. In September, we invested in a new phone system that has allowed our Community Resource Specialists to take calls anywhere. All staff have established quiet and confidential spaces in their homes to take your calls and text messages. Our Resource Database Manager, Lyn, who creates this newsletter and keeps our resource database up-to-date is also working from home. Lyn also has an assistant, Tamie, who has been hard at work as well.

Next, our Center for Prevention Services and Parent Education Center staff have also transitioned to working from home. They are busy recording videos to continue delivering our evidenced-based curriculums to local students. They are using Zoom to deliver parenting curriculums to parents at Courage House.

The prevention staff have been in close contact with our Youth Leadership Council students. The YLC members continue to work on projects to serve the community. The rising seniors on the YLC will be helping Pathways strategically plan for the future of the YLC.

The Board of Directors and I have every confidence that Pathways can weather this pandemic and come out an even stronger and better agency. This year is our 50th Anniversary as an agency. Information on our celebration of this milestone will be out later this year.

To reach the Parent Education Center, dial 740-345-6166 x 230. Our parent educators can give you tips on the handling the stress of managing a full-time job and the full-time education of your children. For those with infants and toddlers, our parent educators have ideas for activities you can do with your children. (Note: Prevention and parenting services are only available in Licking County.)

Pathways of Central Ohio is committed to being part of the effort to help Licking and Knox Counties respond to and recover from this pandemic. We are here for you. If you have






Both Knox and Licking Counties receive calls for the same types of services and agencies. These graphs/charts will give you an idea of needs and referrals based on call data for your individual communities.






The Top Agency graph below no longer includes Answering Service calls as a "referral".

SEARCH Guide

- * Add the location where you are looking for services. You can add the city and/or zip. By adding a zip code your results will sort by proximity to that zip code.
- * Look for an Agency OR a Specific type of Service.
- If you are looking for a specific Agency be sure to use the proper name. If you do not know the full name use the keyword field to search.
- Use the **Service Category** field to search for a service. Begin typing and we will suggest categories that are in our database.
- * To narrow your results even further, use the **Area Served** field to only return results that are available in the area you are looking for help. You can enter a city or specific zip code.
- * Click Search
