Knox County:

Mount Vernon City School District is providing grab-n-go summer breakfasts and lunches for children and youth age 18 years and younger.

Program runs Mon-Fri 11am-12:30pm, through July 31, and will be held at the following locations:

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Licking County:

Licking County grab-n-go lunches (some locations offer breakfast) are provided for children through age 18 during the summer months. The program will run Mon-Fri 11:30am-12:30pm, through August 7 (unless otherwise noted), at the following locations:

- Coble Park, Little Texas
- Licking County Library, Mondays 11am June 1- August 10 (5 meals per week)

Any student under age 18 may receive free meals and snacks through the Summer Food Service Program. Meals and snacks also are available to individuals with disabilities through age 21 who participate in a recognized school program for individuals with developmental or physical disabilities.

For individuals/families facing eviction, looking for assistance with rent payments or may be dealing with utility shut offs due to the COVID-19 pandemic, please encourage them to call 2-1-1 for resources and a listening ear.

If your agency offers assistance in any of these areas, please email Lyn with the program details so we have as many resources as possible to give out to our callers.

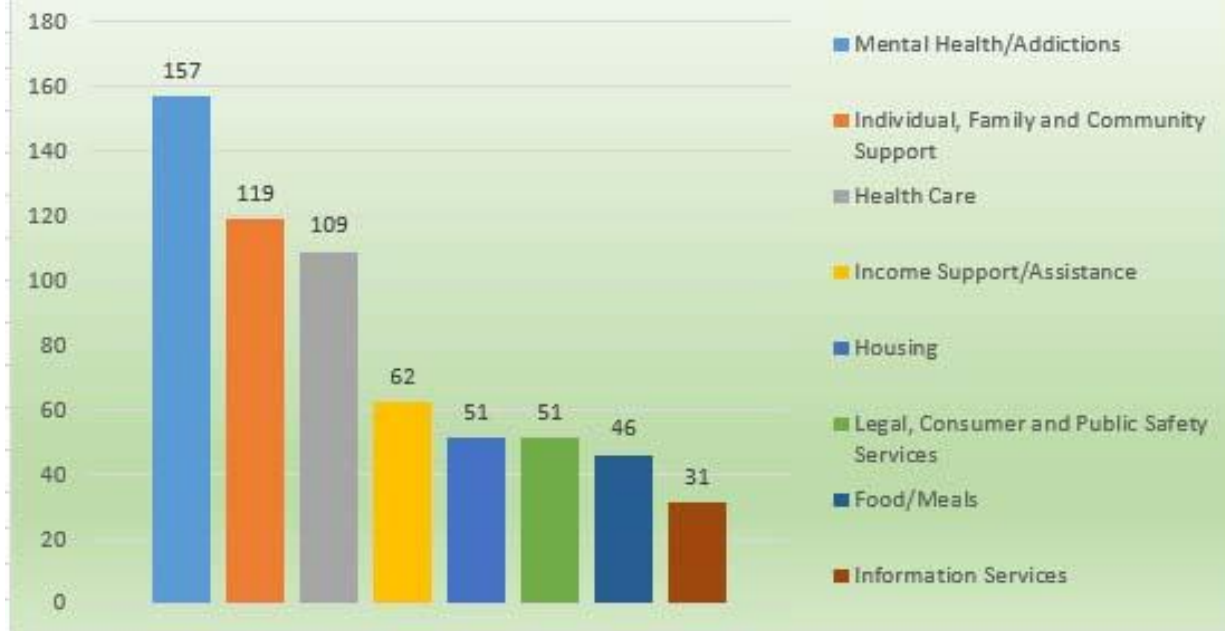


Knox and Licking County Call Totals for the Past 12 Months

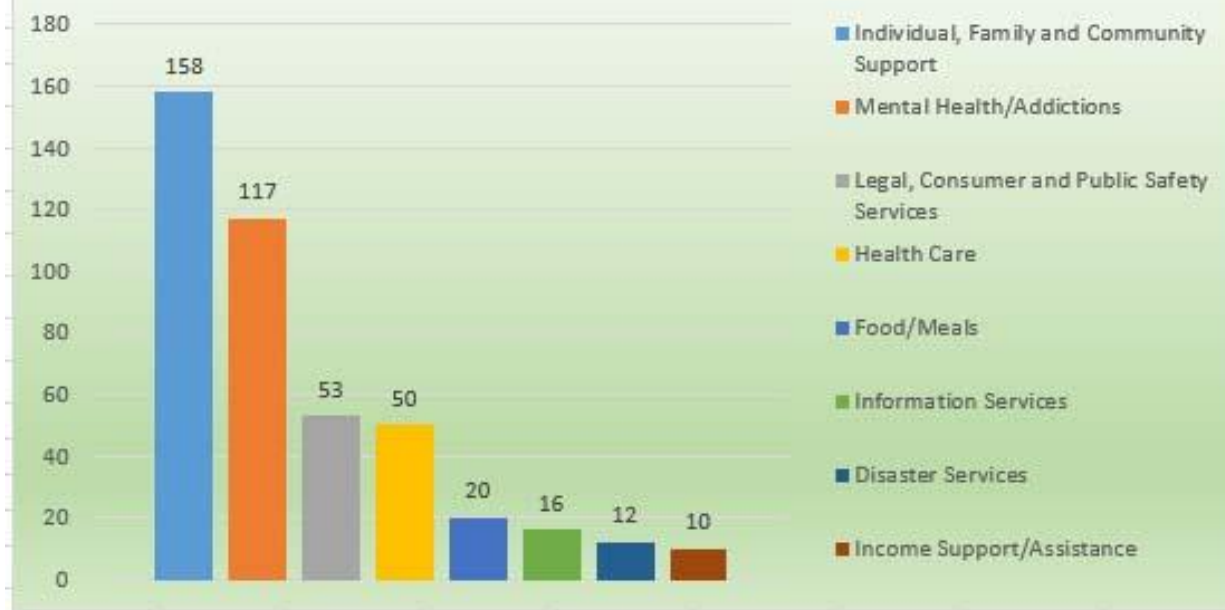

Knox County Top Services Requested - May 2020

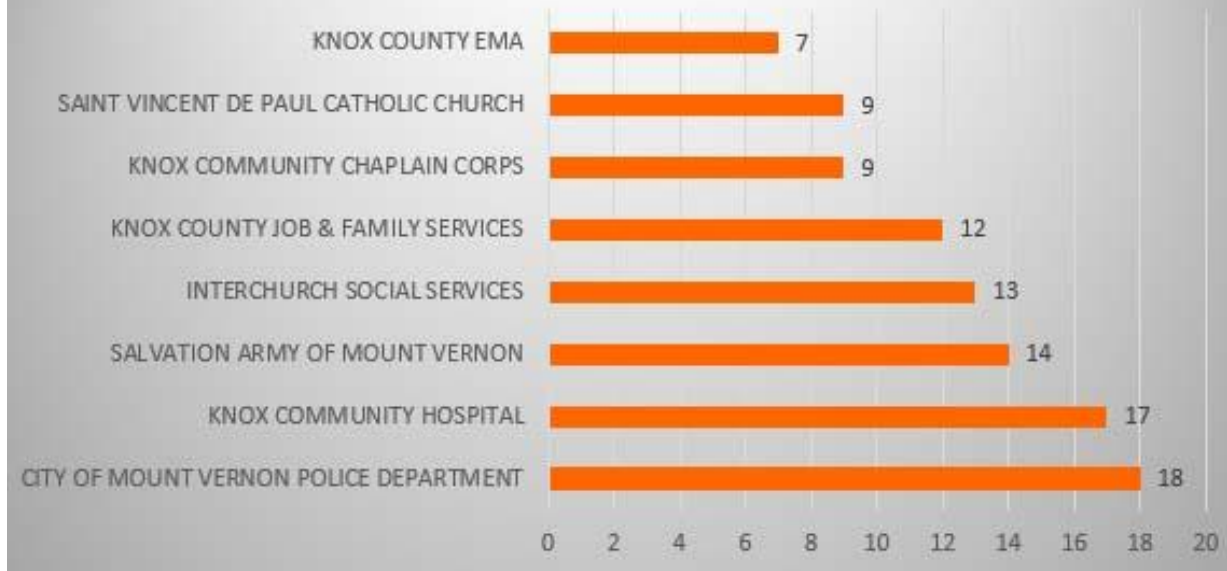


Licking County Top Services Requested - May 2020

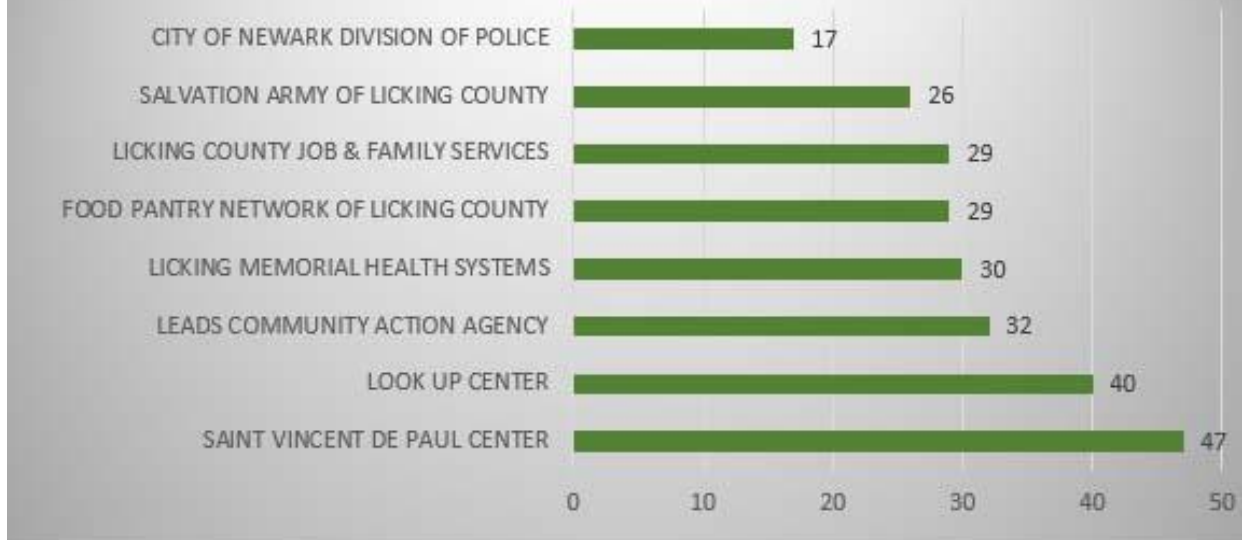

SEARCH Guide

* Add the location where you are looking for services. You can add the city and/or zip. By adding a zip code your results will sort by proximity to that zip code.

* Look for an **Agency** OR a **Specific type of Service**.

- If you are looking for a specific Agency be sure to use the proper name. If you do not know the full name use the keyword field to search.

- Use the **Service Category** field to search for a service. Begin typing and we will suggest categories that are in our database.

* To narrow your results even further, use the **Area Served** field to only return results that are available in the area you are looking for help. You can enter a city or specific zip code.

* Click Search
