

# **CARES Act Housing Relief Fund**

On October 26, The State of Ohio Controlling Board approved the use of \$50 million in state CARES Act Funding for

emergency rental assistance, mortgage assistance, and help with utility bills for qualified Ohioans who have been impacted by the Coronavirus pandemic. Funding will be provided through local Community Action Agencies.

Households who are at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level (a household of four may earn up to \$52,400 in the past 12 months, or \$4,306.85 in the past 30 days) and have fallen behind on rent or mortgage payments, and/or water/sewer bills may be eligible for assistance. COVID19 impact must be documented.

Funds are available for a limited time with the program beginning November 2 and ending December 30th, 2020.
