

Food for the Hungry Collection Drive

On Friday, Dec. 11, community members have the chance to help reduce food insecurity in Knox County, and they can do it in a variety of ways. Collection points include:

- Danville from 9am-2pm at Hometown Market
- Fredericktown from 9am-2pm at Bell Stores
- Gambier from 9am-2pm at The Village Market
- Mount Vernon from 9am-4pm at Aldi, Kroger, Lanning's Foods, Baker's IGA, Rural King and Wal-Mart Supercenter
 - Mount Vernon from 9am-2pm at the Knox Memorial Building

If you cannot make it to one of the drop-off collection points, postal workers throughout Knox County are once again supporting Food for the Hungry. Simply leave an envelope in your mailbox with your cash or check donation. Write "Food for the Hungry Donation" on the outside of the envelope. Checks should be made payable to Food for the Hungry. Postal workers will pick up the envelopes as they come by to deliver your regular Friday mail. It's that easy, and there won't be any charge for postage.

Reminder: CARES Act Housing Relief Fund

On October 26, The State of Ohio Controlling Board approved the use of \$50 million in state CARES Act Funding for emergency rental assistance, mortgage assistance, and help with utility bills for qualified Ohioans who have been impacted by the Coronavirus pandemic. Funding will be provided through local Community Action Agencies.

Households who are at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level (a household of four may earn up to \$52,400 in the past 12 months, or \$4,306.85 in the past 30 days) and have fallen behind on rent or mortgage payments, and/or water/sewer bills may be eligible for assistance. COVID19 impact must be documented.

Funds are available for a limited time with the program beginning November 2 and ending December 30th, 2020.

SEARCH Guide

- * Add the location where you are looking for services. You can add the city and/or zip. By adding a zip code your results will sort by proximity to that zip code.
- * Look for an **Agency** OR a **Specific type of Service**.
- If you are looking for a specific Agency be sure to use the proper name. If you do not know the full name use the keyword field to search.
- Use the **Service Category** field to search for a service. Begin typing and we will suggest categories that are in our database.
- * To narrow your results even further, use the **Area Served** field to only return results that are available in the area you are looking for help. You can enter a city or specific zip code.
