

I&R Day 2021 - Tuesday, November 16, 2021

Every day thousands of people find the help they need quickly, conveniently and free of charge because of Information and Referral (I&R) services. To recognize the importance of I&R in our community, Pathways is observing I&R Day on November 16.

Information and Referral is the art, science and practice of bringing people and services together and is an integral component of the health and human services sector. People in search of critical services such as financial assistance, food, shelter, child care, jobs, or mental health support often do not know where to begin to get help, or they get overwhelmed trying to find what they need. Community information and referral providers connect people with resources that can help them with one simple phone call, text message, or website inquiry.

Pathways provides referrals and information to callers from communities in Central and Southeastern Ohio.

In late 2011, at the request of the Alliance of Information and Referral Services (AIRS), the United States Senate passed S.RES.241 designating November 16, 2011 as "National Information and Referral Services Day". AIRS is an international nonprofit professional association with more than 5000 individual, public and private I&R organizational members including Your Organization. Together, we have decided to continue celebrating I&R Day each November 16

Online Resource Directory Helpful Search Hints

Service Keyword

Search using Service Keyword when you know one of the words in a service term. For example, searching with the words rent will help you find the service term rent payment assistance.

Agency/Program Name

Search using Agency/Program Name when you know one of the words in a service provider name or program name. For example, search with the words red and cross to find American Red Cross locations and see what services are offered.

Guided Search

Search using Guided Search when you are uncertain of the service term. Services are grouped by categories to assist you in finding the particular service need. Click the ? to see a definition of the service terms you find.
