HEAP Summer Crisis Program

The Home Energy Assistance Summer Crisis Program provides a one-time benefit to eligible Ohioans with cooling assistance during the summer months. The program runs from July 1 to September 30.

The focus of the Summer Crisis Program is to provide assistance with electric utility bills, central air conditioning repairs, and air conditioning unit and/or fan purchases. Households who have a disconnect notice, have been shut off, or are trying to establish new electric service may be eligible for assistance. Households with a household member who is either 60 years of age and older or a member who has a certified medical condition may also be eligible.

Ohioans enrolled in the Percentage of Income Payment Plan Plus (PIPP) Program are eligible for assistance towards their default PIPP payment, first PIPP payment, central air conditioning repairs, or may receive an air conditioning unit and/or fan.

MAT is designed to serve individuals 18 years and older. Services include addiction counseling, care coordination, and medication (including Vivitrol and Suboxone). Care Coordination includes referrals for primary care, Hepatitis C treatment, and psychiatry. Medication helps to relieve withdrawal symptoms and psychological cravings.

The MAT Program is available for Licking County residents 18 years and older needing substance abuse treatment.

Knox County clients can participate in the MAT program if willing to travel to the Licking County clinic at 65 Messimer Drive, Newark.
