Knox County Transit: Free Fare Routes

Four routes depicted in image above.

Beginning June 2nd, Knox County Transit has added four new, fixed routes within the city. All of the routes are free to ride. The routes run from 7am-11am and 12pm-5pm; drivers take a lunch break from 11am-12pm.

The four different lines run on a half-hour loop and they all intersect, allowing members of the community to have easier access to get from one end of the city to another.

The four routes are Yauger Jog (Orange), Yellow Jacket Express (Yellow), Round Hill (Red), and Coshocton Express (Blue). The stops will include primary destinations, including Knox Community Hospital, Walmart, and Kroger.

The routes are also considered Flex Routes, meaning drivers can go a short way onto

the side street to pick up passengers assuming the stop still allows the route the arrive at scheduled stops on time. Pick-up requests must be called in to 740-392-7433 two hours prior to the requested time.
